

Sew good GOODS

OH, BABY! BLANKET



1. Press the fabric, trimming the two pieces so they are the same size, if necessary.



2. Pin the two pieces of fabric right sides together, leaving about 6 inches open for turning starting at about 3 inches down from one corner.



3. Sew all the way around with a $\frac{1}{2}$ inch seam allowance, locking stitches at the beginning and end of the opening.
4. Clip the four corners, removing excess fabric, and turn the blanket right sides out. Iron, rolling the edges to press them flat, and turn in the opening seam allowance $\frac{1}{2}$ inch.



5. Pin the Sew Good Goods label in the opening, near the top.

6. Carefully stitch very close to the edge (1/8") all the way around the blanket, being sure to catch the tag.

7. Using the yarn scrap and darning needle, tie the blanket in 5 places (in the center and in each quarter of the blanket), cutting the yarn ends to about 1 inch.
