

OH, BABY! BLANKET



1. Press the fabric, trimming the two pieces so they are the same size, if necessary.



2. Pin the two pieces of fabric right sides together, leaving about 6 inches open for turning starting at about 3 inches down from one corner.



- 3. Sew all the way around with a ½ inch seam allowance, locking stitches at the beginning and end of the opening.
- 4. Clip the four corners, removing excess fabric, and turn the blanket right sides out. Iron, rolling the edges to press them flat, and turn in the opening seam allowance ½ inch.



5. Pin the Sew Good Goods label in the opening, near the top.



6. Carefully stitch very close to the edge (1/8") all the way around the blanket, being sure to catch the tag.



7. Using the yarn scrap and darning needle, tie the blanket in 5 places (in the center and in each quarter of the blanket), cutting the yarn ends to about 1 inch.
