

SWEET DREAMS! PILLOWCASE

QUICK AND EASY

Materials for a standard size pillowcase:

34 yard main fabric, 14 yard edge fabric, 1/8 yard accent band or 41 inches of ribbon (3/4 or 1 inch wide), Sew Good Goods tag

- 1. Press the fabric.
- Fold the edge fabric and accent band fabric in half lengthwise, wrong sides together (right sides out); press.
 If the accent band is a piece of ribbon, there is no need to fold it.
- 3. On a flat surface, layer the fabric in this order, right sides up and raw edges together across the top: main fabric on bottom, then the accent band or ribbon, and finally the edge fabric.

4. Pin all the pieces together across the top, evening up the widths if necessary. Stitch across the top using a ½ inch seam allowance. Zigzag stitch or serge the raw edges.

5. Unfold the edge piece and press the seam flat, making sure the accent band or ribbon is pressed up against the edge piece.









6. With the right sides of the fabric together, fold the pillowcase in half widthwise. *Insert the Sew Good Goods tag into the seam allowance, about 2 inches below the accent band. The tag is designed to show on the outside of the pillowcase.* Pin the side, taking care to line up the edge fabric and accent band seam. Then pin across the bottom. Stitch the side and bottom using a 1/2 inch seam allowance.





Finish the side seam allowance with a zigzag stitch or serger, clip the bottom corners, turn right side out and press.
